Michael Ballance Chosen by Law Schools to Assist in NC Bar Exam Transition

Michael W. Ballance, shareholder of Dickie, McCamey & Chilcote, P.C., has been appointed by the deans of both The University of North Carolina ("UNC") School of Law at Chapel Hill and the Campbell University School of Law in Raleigh to represent the schools in the state's transition to adopting the Uniform Bar Exam.
